## ACQUISITION, RENOVATION AND DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE MEETING

The regular monthly meeting of the Acquisition, Renovation and Development Committee was held on Wednesday, November 19, 2014 at 4:00 p.m. at the Wilmington Housing Authority, 1524 South 16<sup>th</sup> Street, Wilmington, North Carolina

### 1. Call to Order

The meeting of the Acquisition, Renovation, and Development Committee, "ARD" was called to order by Jeffrey G. Hovis, Chair of the Committee, at 4:03 p.m. on November 19, 2014, pursuant to the notice sent to the Commissioners and Staff of Wilmington Housing Authority.

Roll call was taken and a quorum was present.

Ms. Redmon requested a column be added to the attendance section titled "Other Commissioners Present." She also stated in the future she would like to formalize the agenda and roll call in both committee and board meetings. Ms. Redmon explained there also needs to be a separate meeting/agenda for the instrumentalities. She explained WHA and HEO would be opened and closed separately during the ARD Committee.

Deb Hays entered the meeting at this time.

### 2. Approval of Minutes

Minutes of the October 21, 2014 ARD Committee meeting were reviewed, Commissioner Hays made the motion to approve and Commissioner Neel seconded. Minutes were unanimously approved

### 3. RAD (Construction)

Mr. Floyd reported the storm water permit was received along with the erosion control permit. He stated the contractor is working on the 16 unit number for the RAD construction. Mr. Floyd stated staff is working on the RAD closing.

Commissioner Neel asked where we stood with the HUD approval talked about at last month's committee meeting and Ms. Redmon stated staff is working with HUD on the over housing issue.

### **4. SHDP1**

Mr. Floyd stated the same contractor that is doing RAD is also the contractor for SHDP1. He stated if the contractor can't do both projects at once it would run our costs up.

Commissioner Hovis asked if staff had updated Elderhaus and Karen Schraml said not recently. Ms. Redmon stated she would set an appointment with them.

### 5. Rankin Terrace LIHTC

Mr. Floyd reported staff is working on closing and next Tuesday they will be signing the documents. He stated the contractor is on board and a meeting with zoning is scheduled for December 2<sup>nd</sup>. Permits for the rehab and recreation building have been received.

Ms. Redmon reported the slowdown has been with HUD DC and Greensboro.

Ms. Redmon stated the update regarding the subsidy layering and competitive procurement waiver will be in the report for the board.

### 6. Project Matrix

Mr. Floyd reported on the following:

- Lighting is done at Eastbrook, Vesta and Creekwood is complete.
- Staff is currently working on the 5-Year Agency Plan.
- Staff is working with operations on vacancies to streamline the scope of work and the time it takes getting contractors into the unit.
- Sunset South ponds have been inspected and minor issues will be fixed. The homeowners association will take possession of the permit.

### 7. Resolutions

Ms. Redmon stated that due to the length of time that has passed HUD has requested the following resolutions be approved again by the board.

- a) Resolution No. 0924 authorizing the rehabilitation of Rankin Terrace
- b) Resolution No. 12-029 authorizing HEO the manager member of HEO Partners IV, LLC the manager-member of Rankin Place Terrace, LLC

Ms. Schraml reported No. 12-029 authorizes HEO to be the managing member for the LLC and No. 0924 allows WHA to have a ground lease and acquisition loan.

Commissioner Neel stated he would recuse himself from the formal vote at the board meeting.

The committee recommended the resolutions go before the board for approval.

### 8. Other Business

Commissioner Hovis asked what the status is of the 5 bedroom handicap unit at Vesta and Mr. Floyd stated numerous attempts to make contact have been made but nothing has been heard in return.

Commissioner Hovis reported there is 10 to 15 unit property for development on the North end and will get that information to Ms. Redmon.

The committee discussed the need for one bedroom units to help fix the over housing issue along with the need for independent senior living. The discussion included different options within the city.

### 9. Adjournment

A motion made by Commissioner Hays and seconded by Commissioner Neel to adjourn the meeting carried unanimously.
